- In this round, each team is supposed to submit a basic ideology of their business plan in the form of a PDF on the registration link before the given deadline. Shortlisted candidates will move on to the second round. You will be informed about the results 48 hours before the event. The PDF can include the following -
- · Title of the proposed project
- Team members (name, telephone, email address)
- Brief summary of product goals and plans (not to exceed 450 words)
- Brief description of what is unique about the project.
- · Round 2:
- This is the presentation round which will be conducted on the day of the fest i.e. 3rd April 2023. Finalists will be required to pitch their respective startup plans intensively with a PowerPoint presentation and will have to answer certain questions related to their plans.
- Participants can include the following in their presentations:
- Industry and competition
- Target Markets
- Financing
- Community Involvement
- The presenters will have 5 minutes to present the concept, followed by 5 minutes of questioning. The winning project, or projects, deemed to be the most innovative will be announced at the conclusion of the competition.

- · All teams must have at least two members.
- Teams must remain together throughout the Treasure Hunt and are encouraged to work together to answer the riddles and get the coins from each site.
- There are no refunds for entry costs.
- At the start of the treasure hunt, each team will be issued a "Clue Booklet". The pamphlet will contain all of the treasure hunt clues. It is up to the teams to decode the clues and carefully retrieve the coin from each place. Each solved clue will lead you to a location where you can acquire a "Treasure Hunt Coin."
 Whether or whether all clues are solved and coins are recovered, teams must return to the Exploration Area within the time limit to be eligible for awards.
- Teams will be graded based on the overall value of the coins collected as well as the amount of time it takes.
 Once all coins have been gathered, teams must return to the finish line to be considered done. The difficulty of the clue will decide coin values.
- A number is issued to each team in the quest. On the day of the hunt, you will be given a piece of paper with this number on it when you sign in. Tape this paper to one of the team's members' shirts, with the number facing out.
- Decision of the judges will be final and binding

 - Stealing from other teams.
 - · Copying from other teams.


